White Oak Technology Park is a master-planned, publicly owned industrial park located at the intersection of I-64 and I-295 in tax-friendly Henrico County. The 2,270-acre park boasts the extensive, reliable utility and transportation infrastructure today's most advanced manufacturing facilities and data centers demand. With 1,300 acres of build-ready industrial land remaining, White Oak Technology Park is one of the premier development opportunities on the East Coast.

The park boasts a robust infrastructure network, including double circuit, dual feed 230kV line, 10+ MGD water and sewer capacity, and a dense fiber network. White Oak's proximity to major interstates, deep labor pool, and location in low-tax Henrico County has attracted major corporations such as QTS, Hewlett-Packard, Air Liquide, and Facebook.

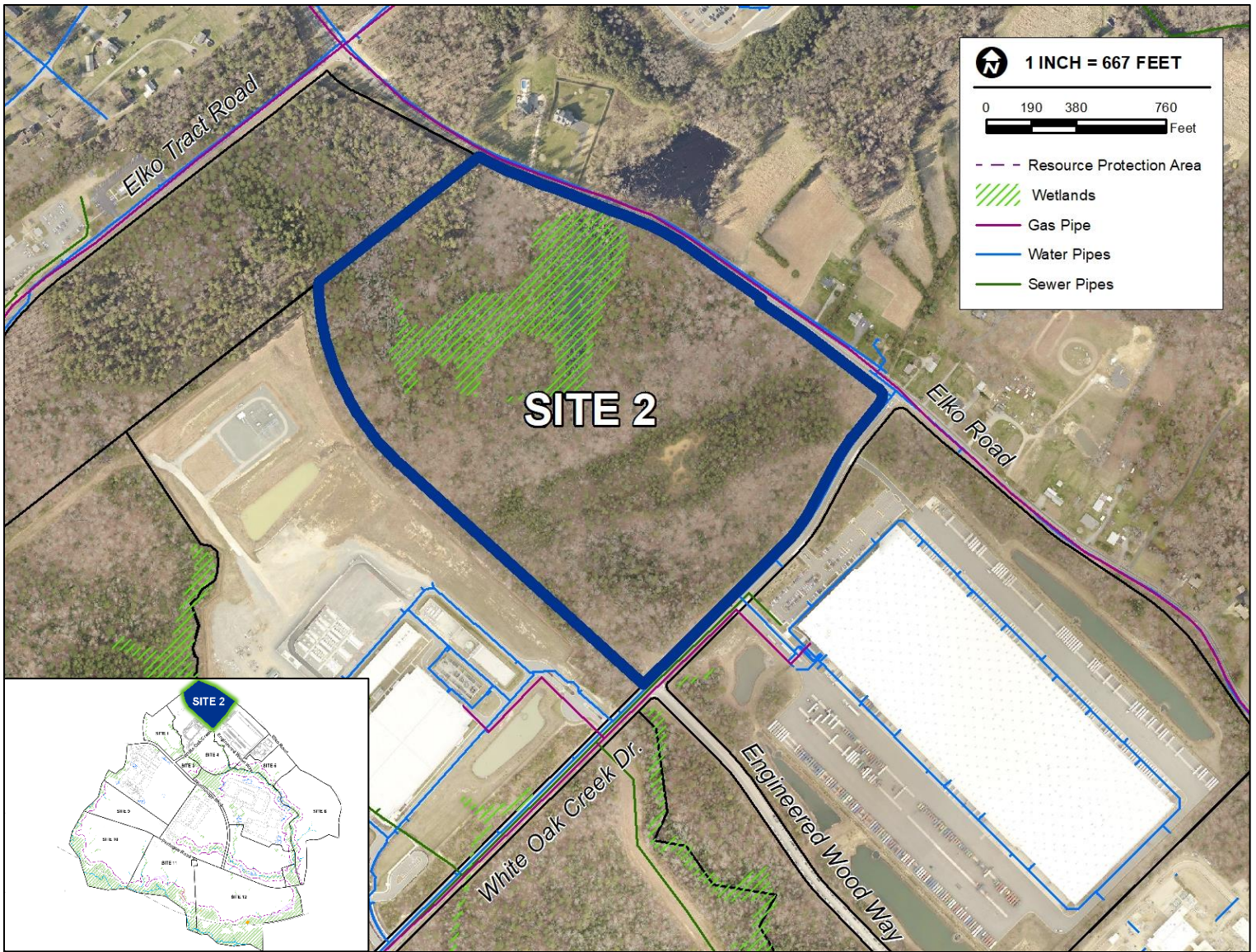
